# Baby Quilt - Embroidered 6" Squares

#### **Materials**

60" of backing fabric (45" wide)
18 fat quarters (you use only about half of each for the squares)
<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> m. of fabric for the strips on the pieced side
60" of cotton batting (this will be enough to do 2 quilts since the batting is 90" wide)
5 strips of 2 ½" binding (45" wide)

# Cut

## **Squares**

35 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares (2 of each color plus one more) Aligned in 7 rows of 5 squares

## Strips

All strips are cut on the width of the fabric (45")

 $5 \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " X 45" (these are for the outside border - the long ones will have to be pieced) 11 X 2" X 45" (Cut 5 of these into 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for a total of 30)

The short strips go between the squares in the rows - 4 for each row of 5 squares The remaining 6 strips go between each of the 7 rows

Overall width of quilt:  $40 \frac{1}{2}$ " Overall length of quilt:  $55 \frac{1}{2}$ "
